- Regulations set by the University provide that non-degree course work cannot normally be applied toward a graduate degree at Ohio University. You may take no more than 18 hours of academic work, within a time limit of six years, as a non-degree student.
If you decide to apply for admission to a degree program after you have entered as a non-degree student, you are urged to apply within the first quarter after being admitted as a non-degree student. You will need to resubmit the graduate school application and pay an application fee. Such fees are set by Ohio University Graduate College. To apply & for fees: www.ohio.edu/graduate/apply.cfm
You will be considered for non-degree admission after you have submitted (1) two official transcripts showing the highest degree awarded, (2) the standard application for admissions to graduate school, (3) an application fee (check or money order to be made payable to Ohio University), (4) this completed form.
Please note: (1) Applicants whose highest degree was awarded by Ohio University will have their transcript ordered for them; (2) Applicants that are starting non-degree while completing admission requirements to a degree program will be required to submit transcripts from ALL schools attended; (3) Faculty, civil service and contract people will not be required to pay the application fee. Applicants checking item C should consult with the program coordinator in order to ensure that they take courses in the proper sequence.
